### General:

### Academic:

- Must be a graduate of Tigard or Tualatin High School with a minimum accumulated GPA of at least **3.0** after the seventh semester.
- Must be planning to attend **college or university**.
- Must demonstrate commitment to achieving the highest attainable personal level of academic performance.

### Financial:

- Applicant's need for financial assistance will be considered amongst all the other items.
- Scholarship is for one year of support in the amount of \$2500.

### Leadership and Involvement:

- During high school, applicant has, by conduct and activities, demonstrated characteristics of leadership and good citizenship within the high school campus, community and elsewhere.
- Must also show a true commitment to service to their school and community.

### To demonstrate that you meet the Standards of the Scholarship requirements:

- Describe a Science project that you have made or been involved in creating or demonstrating.
- Please describe in a paragraph what area of science interests you most and why.
- Attach letters of recommendation from two (2) of the following individuals: teachers, school counselors, employers, other
