Alberta Rider Elementary	\$1400	Art Literacy - Purchase additional materials to increase the engagement for students.
Art Rutkin Elementary	\$1400	Student & Community Art Project - Variety of interior wall artwork on canvas or wood reflecting positive community messages, symbols and images for kindness, togetherness and other student generated ideas/designs. Ideas would also connect to our school's SAFE, CONSIDERATE and RESPONSIBLE behavior expectations.
Bridgeport Elementary	\$1400	Bridgeport Musical - After School Drama Club Production of Willy Wonka y el chocolate, which is a bilingual musical performed by Bridgeport students. - Students will perform the parts, create the set, and design the costumes.
Byrom Elementary	\$1400	Art Literacy - Chagall Stained Glass Project.
CFT Elementary	\$1400	Ballroom Dancing - Teaches the basics of ballroom dancing to 4th and 5th grade students, culminating in an evening performance for all 4th and 5th graders.
Deer Creek Elementary	\$1400	Sound System - upgrade to sound system on the stage and used in the cafeteria.
Durham Elementary	\$1400	Art Literacy - Purchase Art literacy supplies and 2 large canvases for a school wide art project.
Mary Woodward Elementary	\$1400	Ballroom Dancing with Impressions Dance Club - Teaches the basics of ballroom dancing to 4th and 5th grade students, culminating in an evening performance for all 4th and 5th graders.
Metzger Elementary	\$1400	Art Literacy - Art Like Us - Artists are selected that represent our students and families and also include intentionally chosen artists representing diverse cultures, races, ages, nationalities, abilities, and more. The artists' medium and character traits are used to teach students valuable lessons in social justice, social emotional skills, CASEL competencies, and art standards.

Templeton Elementary	\$1400	Art Literacy Supplies for a variety of school-wide art projects in every classroom.
Tualatin Elementary	\$1400	Tualatin Elementary Arts Foundation(TEAF) Staffing - to offer after school enrichment classes, including choir, dance, ceramics and art classes.
Fowler Middle School	\$3400	Band - purchase a new bassoon.
Hazelbrook Middle School	\$3400	Drama - Update, replace and supplement drama equipment to accommodate growth in the drama department.
Twality Middle School	\$3400	Orchestra & Band - Rental for 11 Violins, 2 Trombones, 3 trumpets and a percussion kit.
Creekside High School	\$5500	Art Classes - Materials, equipment, and supplies to support multiple arts-based learning opportunities at Creekside: Printmaking, Studio Art, Art Foundations, Photography, and Performing Arts.
Tigard High School	\$5500	Theatre Department - sound equipment that would benefit the Theatre Department on many levels. The equipment would improve sound quality improving student performances, as well as provide the tech theatre students the opportunity to work with equipment which would be used in the industry making it easier for them to get internships and or jobs.

The storage equipment is for the safe and efficient storage of our existing supply of standing easels. Performing Arts Theatre - Canon XA65 Professional UHD 4K Camcorder Band & Orchestra - Korg TM-60 tuners that all students can use to tune their instruments. Choir - commissioning a piece of music by a local composer to perform at the ORegon Music Educators Association Conference.
