Alberta Rider	\$1100	Art Literacy Supplies - Funding more costly materials (fabric, thread, stamps) to create more lasting artifacts. Students will also be creating a collaborative walkthrough exhibit utilizing black lights and reflective paint to display in the Art Lit classroom.
Art Rutkin	\$1100	School-Wide Community Project - Funding to generate a variety of interior wall artwork on canvas or wood reflecting positive community messages, symbols and images for student generated ideas/designs. Ideas would also connect to our school's SAFE, CONSIDERATE and RESPONSIBLE behavior expectations.
Bridgeport	\$1100	Bridgeport Musical, A Year of Frog and Toad Funding 3 staff members for this popular afterschool production for 4th and 5th graders.
Byrom	\$1100	New Stage Dropdown Microphones Purchasing dropdown (overhead) microphones designed for stage and live event environments.
CFT	\$1100	Musical Instruments Purchasing new instruments - nuvo jsax, nuvo jflute, nuvo clarineo, nuvo jhorn, pBone trombone, and the pBone trumpet.
Deer Creek	\$1100	Ballroom Dance Instruction - Funding ballroom instructor to teach the basics of ballroom dancing to 4th and 5th grade students, culminating in an evening performance for all 4th and 5th graders.
Durham	\$1100	Garden Shed Mural and Garden Bench Murals - Funding mural artist and paint supplies for students to paint garden benches to complete this next phase of beautifying the school's garden.
Mary Woodward	\$1100	Laptop Easels for Garden Art - Purchasing 36 laptop easels that would allow students to sit in the school garden and draw the natural surroundings, instead of using small clipboards.

Fowler Middle	\$3000	Ceramics Department - Funding ceramics throwing wheel repair, glazes and tools. Band Department - Funding Band Ensemble & Method Books.
Hazelbrook Middle	\$0	Was not able to apply in time.
Twality Middle	\$3200	Performing Arts - Purchasing supplemental light system for the stage and performance area to improve the controls and stage lighting.
Creekside Community High	\$5000	Launching Music Program! - Purchasing the instruments, equipment, and instructional materials necessary to launch a new fine arts program at Creekside, addressing a significant and long-standing gap in access to arts education for their students. The program will be a community-responsive music ensemble that centers student voice, cultural relevance, and inclusive participation. Students of all musical backgrounds and skill levels will rehearse and perform together, engaging with high-interest music across multiple genres. The program will culminate in quarterly public performances, providing students with authentic opportunities to demonstrate learning, build confidence, and strengthen connections with families and the broader community. By reducing barriers to participation and emphasizing collaboration over competition, this program will expand equitable access to the arts, foster belonging, and support student engagement and well-being.

Guitar Program - Funding replacement cables for the guitars and basses in the program.
